
We have prepared this set of questions to help you study for your written test. The New Jersey Driver Manual should be studied carefully, the information in this brochure is from the manual and should be of value before taking the written test.

1. When 2 roads intersect and there are no signs or signals, it is good practice to be ready to stop if necessary.
2. **You must park at least:** 10 feet from a fire hydrant, 50 feet from stop sign, 25 feet from a crosswalk, 75 feet opposite curb of a fire station, and 20 feet same side as a fire station
3. When making a left turn from a two-way road onto a 4 lane highway, the proper way to turn is to approach the turn as close to the centerline as possible, make the turn before reaching the center of the intersection, and turn into the left lane of the road going in your direction.
4. When approaching or nearing a uncontrolled intersection you should reduce speed and be ready to stop.
5. Dim your lights to low beam when a car is approaching you or when you are behind another car.
6. On a two-lane road, not near a school, when a school bus is stopped and its red lights are flashing you must stop.
7. In the event of a crash or sudden stop, use of seat belts may keep you from being thrown from the car, hitting the windshield or dashboard, and from sliding off the seat and losing control of the car.
8. Driving under the influence means that your senses and judgment are impaired.
9. Studies show most people who have been arrested for drunk driving were drinking beer.
10. To safely share the road with large trucks and buses you must know the limitations of these vehicles regarding visibility, stopping distances required, and maneuverability.
11. You can reduce your chances of being involved in an accident by knowing and using the standard accident prevention formula of being alert, prepared, and acting in time.
12. If a vehicle is passing you slow down to make it easier for the driver to make the pass in time.
13. If you approach an intersection and a large truck is stopped for the traffic light, you should stop with enough distance so you will not be in a blind spot and you can see the driver in his mirror.
14. If you are under 21 years of age and drive a vehicle with as little as 0.01% blood alcohol concentration, you are subject to a penalty of a 30 to 90 day license suspension, 15 to 30 days community service, and participation in a intoxicated driver resource center or other alcohol education safety program.
15. In New Jersey, studded snow tires can be legally used between November 15th and April 1st.
16. The best way to reduce your chances of having an alcohol related accident is to not drive at all after drinking.
17. The meaning of a hand-signal when a driver's hand and arm are upward is a right-turn.
18. The best way to take a curve is to slow down before entering the curve.
19. The driver and all passengers are required by the GDL law to wear a seat belt in a vehicle.
20. Road surfaces are most slippery during the first few minutes of rainfall.
21. You should always yield to emergency vehicles, pedestrians, and other vehicles already in the intersection.
22. Altering a driver's license, or

showing an altered license may result in a fine of \$1,000, up to 6 months in jail, and loss of your driving privilege.

23. The following drinks are equal in alcohol content: 12 oz. of beer, 5 oz. of table wine, and 1 ½ oz. of 86 proof whiskey.

24. In adverse weather conditions, a truck takes longer to stop. This can be as much as 25% more.

25. New Jersey speed limit in a business or residential area is 25 mph.

26. To regain control while in a skid, you should turn in the same direction the back of the car is skidding.

27. You cannot take your road test in a vehicle with any obstruction or consoles between the driver and the examiner because the examiner cannot reach the brakes.

28. Effective July 1, 2004, motorists in NJ may not use a hand held wireless telephone while driving except if there is a fire, traffic accidents, and medical emergencies.

29. The order of colors on a traffic light hung top to bottom is red, yellow, and green.

30. High beam lights are used for open country driving.

31. You cannot park within 25 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.

32. Any passengers from their shared residence plus 1 additional person may accompany the holder of a validated GDL special learners permit in a vehicle.

33. The holder of a provisional license who is under 21 may have 1 non household member in their vehicle.

34. The holder of a validated GDL student learner permit must pass a road test, attain 17 years of age, and have a 6 month minimum of supervised driving to obtain a provisional license.

35. The fine for violations of any of the conditions of the GDL permits or provisional license is \$100.

36. The meaning of a hand signal when a driver's hand and arm are downward is slow or stop.

37. Whether your blood alcohol content rises above legal limits depends on, the amount you drink, your weight, and time you take to drink.

38. If not prohibited by a no turn on red sign, NJ law permits you to turn right on red after making a full stop and checking traffic.

39. Laws in NJ require you to keep to the right except when impractical, when passing, and when on a one way street.

40. If you go into a skid you should

take your foot off the gas pedal.

41. When sharing the road with large trucks or buses, you should give more roadway to a truck making a wide turn, leave more space, and maintain a consistent speed when passing.

42. A motorist will be subject to a suspension of driving privileges for a conviction of a 3rd violation of operation under the influence of liquor/drugs.

43. Before turning you must signal at least 100 feet in advance.

44. The holder of a validated GDL Examination permit (21 years of age or older) is required to drive with supervision for a minimum of 3 months.

45. Emotions have a great effect on your driving, if you are angry or excited you should give yourself time to cool off.

46. The holder of a validated GDL special learners permit must not drive between the hours of 11:01pm and 5:00am.

47. A triangular shaped sign is a yield sign.

48. The holder of a student permit must have an adult supervising driver in the front seat, Permit, Registration and insurance card.

49. When pavement is marked with 2

center lines, 1 solid and 1 broken, passing is permitted only on the side with the broken line.

50. NJ law allows up to 3 points be subtracted from your driving record if you have no moving traffic violation for 1 year from the date of your last violation.

51. If a driver of a large truck or bus cannot see you in his rearview mirrors, then you are in the trucks no-zone or blind spot.

52. A single solid white line across a road at an intersection means to stop behind the line for a traffic signal or light.

53. When nearing a steady yellow or amber traffic light, stop before the intersection if you can do so safely.

54. A twelve ounce can of beer has as much alcohol as 1 ½ ounces of 86 proof liquor.

55. Getting a driver's license illegally may result in a fine of \$200-\$500, and or imprisonment for 30-90 days.

56. If under 21, NJ law states that you may be under the influence if your blood alcohol level content is more than .01%.

57. A supervising driver for the holder of a validated GDL permit must be at least 21 years or older, NJ licensed driver, and be licensed for at least 3 years.

Motor vehicles.

68. The holder of a provisional license, under 21 may drive unsupervised as long as the road test was passed and 6 months of supervised driving is completed.

69. When parking uphill on a street with a curb on your right, your car wheel should be turned away from the curb.

70. The driving hours of a GDL Examination permit and provisional (under 21) license is 5:01 am – midnight.

71. If a person gets drunk in your home, and has a motor vehicle accident after leaving your home you could be involved in a lawsuit.

72. A provisional driver is provisional for 1 year.

73. When parking downhill with a curb to the right, wheels should be turned towards the curb.

74. You cannot park in front of a fire hydrant, bus stop, or a driveway.

75. Double solid lines in the center of a 2 way road means traffic should not cross from either side.

76. A person may operate a moped with a moped, basic, or motorcycle license. All must be valid.

77. The best way to reduce your chances of having an alcohol

58. The holder of a validated GDL permit (21 or older) has no restricted driving hours.

59. NJ law requires that a child must be seated in a child restraint device if the child is under 5 years old and riding in the front seat, the child is under 18 months old front or back seat.

60. In city driving look 12 seconds ahead.

61. The 2 second rule can be used at any speed to keep a safe following distance.

62. If you drink and reach a BAC of .05% your risk of causing a motor vehicle accident doubles.

63. If you approach an intersection with a large truck stopped at the traffic light, you should stop with enough distance so you will not be in a blind spot, and you can see the driver in his mirror.

64. At .10% BAC your risk of causing a Motor vehicle accident is 6 times as great.

65. If a person had been drinking Time is the only way to sober up.

66. The best way to talk to other drivers on the road is to use your horn and lights.

67. If you sell your car and not buy another turn in license plates to

related accident is to not drive at all after drinking.

78. A Railroad crossing sign is a black and yellow circle.

79. If your wheels drift onto the dirt shoulder of a road, and you want to return to the paved road, you should slow down and turn back onto the pavement slowly.

80. At the time of your road test you must present a valid registration, Insurance card, and a permit.

81. A green light means go when safe.

82. If you have a flat tire or blow out you should grip the wheel firmly, let up on the gas, and let the car coast to a stop.

83. When driving around a curve, your vehicle will tend to keep going straight.

84. When approaching a railroad crossing with flashing lights you must stop at the crossing.

85. Any change of address must be reported to MVC within 1 week.

86. Any change of name must reported to MVC within 2 weeks.

87. To avoid highway hypnosis when driving on an expressway avoid looking at any one thing for more than a few seconds.

88. Hydroplaning is driving condition

wherein tires lose traction on a wet road and float on a layer of water or slush when this happens you should slow down.

89. If under 21, NJ law states that you maybe under the influence if your blood alcohol content is more than .01% but less than .15%.

90. Emergency vehicles use sirens, red, or blue flashing lights. Always pull to the extreme right of the roadway.

91. When you move into NJ from another state you must have your vehicle inspected within 14 days of registering it.

92. The speed limit in a school zone is 25 mph.

93. NJ law states if you are 21 or over you may or may not be under the influence if your blood alcohol content is more than .05% but less than .08%.

94. The shape of a yield sign is a triangle.

95. Signals should be used when changing lanes, turning, and when slowing down.

96. On a two lane road not near a school when a school bus is stopped and its red lights are flashing you must stop.

97. If you have a tire blowout you should slow down gradually.

98. The holder of a special learners permit is eligible for a basic license at age 18 years of age.

99. A provisional driver, during daylight hours when raining, must have wipers and headlights on.

100. A diamond shaped sign is a warning sign.

101. A deceleration lane is an extra lane at a highway exit.

102. The holder of a provisional license is not permitted to use a hand held electronic device, video game, or a cell phone,

103. An eight sided sign means stop.

104. If you miss a exit on a expressway go on to the next exit.

105. It is good practice to keep a space cushion to give you time to react.

106. When driving at night be sure you can stop with in the distance you can see ahead.

107. When passing a large truck or bus it is important to remember that there are several no zones or blind spots in which the driver cannot see you.

108. You may pass on the right when the driver ahead of you is turning left and there is a proper lane on the right.

109. When your license is returned to

you after suspension or after completing a driver improvement program you will be on probation for 1 year.

110. One and one-half ounces of 86 proof whiskey contains the same amount of alcohol as 12 ounces of beer.

111. To regain control while in a skid turn in the same direction the back of car is skidding.

112. A provisional driver is provisional for 1 year.

113. By law, you are under the influence when the amount of alcohol in your blood or BAC reaches .08%.

114. Under GDL law, a person is required a remedial training class when getting 4 or more points or a DUI.

115. Implied consent law means when you drive a motor vehicle you automatically agree to take a breath test following an arrest for a suspected drinking and driving offense.

116. Every vehicle in NJ must be insured for liability.

117. After 2 to 4 drinks, alcohol begins to impair your reaction time, coordination, and judgement.

118. Operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs and refuse breath test and

convicted will result in an insurance surcharge.

119. A motorist will be subject to suspension of driving privileges for a conviction of a 3rd violation of operation under the influence of liquor/drugs.

120. If a student driver commits a traffic offense, responsibility will be with both student and instructor.
